REGISTER TO VOTE?

Registrations are taken at the Clerk's Office during regular business hours. You may also register to vote at any Secretary of State Office in Michigan. The Clerk's Office is open on the second Wednesday of every month until 7:00 p.m. (Passports may be obtained until 6:30 p.m. ONLY on Wednesday).

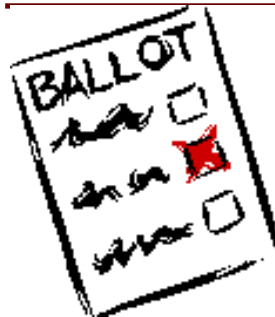

HOW DO I RECEIVE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT?



You can obtain an application for absentee ballot [online](#) **link* or by either calling or coming into your Clerk's Office prior to an election. Voters 60 years of age and over are automatically sent applications for absentee ballots 75 days prior to the election. Applications must be signed and returned for every election before a ballot will be sent. The Clerk's Office will be open the Saturday prior to each election [until 2:00 p.m.] for anyone wishing to receive an absentee ballot.
