Sealed Bid Proposals for the construction of the WEST BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP 2010 SAD – POTOMAC TOWNE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS in Oakland County, Michigan will be received by the Clerk of the Owner, Charter Township of West Bloomfield, 4550 Walnut Lake Road, West Bloomfield, Michigan 48325 until **10:00 AM Local Time on Thursday, February 17, 2011**, at which time and location all bids will be publicly opened, identified and subject to disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act.

This project consists of the construction of roadway improvements within the “Potomac Towne” subdivision in West Bloomfield, Oakland County, Michigan. The approximate quantities of the major items of work are:

The proposed work includes drainage structure improvements, concrete curb and gutter removal and replacement, HMA pulverizing, station grading modified, HMA placement and restoration. All work shall be in accordance with the Bidding Documents prepared by the Engineer. Each sealed Proposal shall be marked “**West Bloomfield Township 2010 SAD – Potomac Towne Roadway Improvements**” and shall have attached a Bid Bond as described in the Bidding Documents in an amount equal to 5% of the base bid amount.

Bidding Documents will be mailed to Bidders upon receipt of \$75 (CD version) per set or \$125.00 per set (paper copy), not refundable.

Attention is called to the fact that for all parts of the Project, no less than the minimum salaries and wages must be paid on this Project as required by the Minimum Wage Act of 1964, as amended, MCL §408.381, et seq, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin, in accordance with the Elliott-Larsen Civil Rights Act, MCL §37.2101, et seq.

West Bloomfield Township reserves the right to reject any or all bids, modify quantities, negotiate with one or more bidders and to waive any irregularities in bidding, and to make the award as may appear to be in the best interest of West Bloomfield Township.
