

The Charter Township of West Bloomfield is committed to protecting the high-quality of life for its residents through maintaining and protecting its beautiful natural resources. Home to acres of regulated woodlands, the Township has strict ordinances limiting the public's ability to alter these areas or cut trees, but with the understanding that safety issue trees do pose a threat to human health and property. When a resident is concerned about a tree within a regulated wetland or woodland area and/or a 25' environmental features setback area, an Environmental Department employee can help determine the appropriate actions for the tree removal.

Each tree of concern should be brightly tagged, and the Environmental Department should be notified at (248) 451-4818 to set up an inspection time. If the tree needs be altered or removed, the inspector will provide all permit information necessary.
