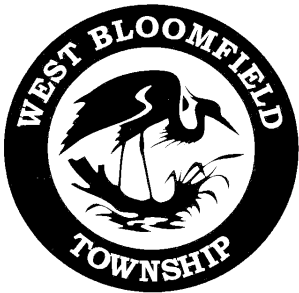

ELECTRONICS

Computers and Monitors, Typewriters, Microwave Ovens, Phones, Pagers, Printers, Fax Machines, Scanners, PDA's, Stereos, Radios, Cassette Players, Walkmans, CD Players, MP3 Players, Clocks and TV's. A "Certificate of Recycling" and a "Certificate of Hard Drive Destruction" are available from vendor at no extra charge. **Electronics should not be in boxes.**

SHREDDING: On-site shredding of **PERSONAL** documents (no business records) will be available – maximum 50 pounds per household.

SALVATION ARMY: The Salvation Army will be on site (*Saturday only*) for a "Donation Drive". You may donate your gently used clothing, furniture and household goods. A tax donation receipt will be provided by their staff. **NO HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** For further information log onto: www.SalArmyThrift.com
