Re: West Bloomfield Township – Sanitary Sewer Manhole Rehabilitation

Dear Valued Customer,

We would like to take this opportunity to advise you that a sanitary sewer rehabilitation project is scheduled to commence in your area very soon. The project involves repairing sanitary sewer manholes in the Evergreen Farmington Sewage Collection System with the intent of removing Infiltration and Inflow (I &I or Clearwater) from the collection system. This is significant because the Township pays for every gallon of sewage that flows out of the system. We are happy to tell you that we have been successful in getting the project funded with low interest loans and with partial funding by Federal stimulus monies.

The Contractor that will be working in your area is DiPonio Contracting of Shelby, Michigan. This is a reputable Contractor with years of experience in this field. Activities are scheduled to commence during the month of February and continue throughout the summer and fall. Work on your specific street should not last longer than a few weeks in duration. Permitted hours of work are Monday thru Friday 7:00 am to 7:00 pm and 10:00 am to 7:00 pm on Saturdays.

Construction activities at the manholes involve repairing and rebuilding covers and sealing various portions of the manholes. All work activities will be confined to public rights of way or easements. Your Water & Sewer Department takes great pride in serving this community and will work to ensure that all repairs involving surface restoration will be made as promptly as possible upon completion, weather permitting.

We certainly appreciate your cooperation as these necessary improvements and rehabilitation activities are being implemented throughout the Township. Again, these upgrades to the system are being implemented by the Township to remove excess flow from the sewage collection system in order to comply with Michigan Department of Environmental Quality standards for our community. Our engineers for the project, Johnson & Anderson Inc, will have a representative on the site that will be able to answer any questions on how the project may affect your individual residence. These individuals will be wearing identification badges and hard hats with a Johnson and Anderson logo.
